



Mentors Matter new Volunteer Guide

Background checks—Police and Intervention Record Check. This can take up to 8 weeks until or more. Training and reference checks are completed during this waiting period.



Orientation Training:

1. online through Alberta Mentoring Partnership	1 hour
2. In person orientation at Hull Services	3 hours
3. Follow up online training	30 minutes



Matching: Once approved, we will contact you regarding a potential match. Meet with referring staff, or program .

TCBC Mentors—tour the program and receive program specific safety training. Create schedule.

Meet with caregiver and young person or program. Complete paperwork.

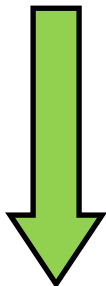
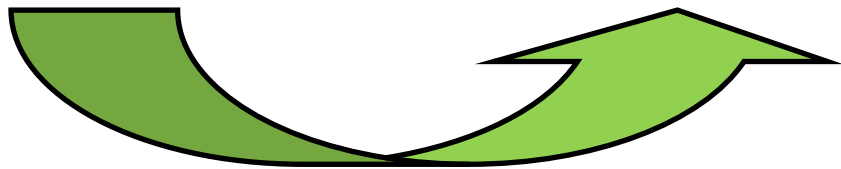
1:1 Community Mentors—plan three supported visits within one month. Then arrange ongoing visits with mentee and caregiver.



Post Match Training: All mentors attend 8 hours of post match training. Behavior Support for Mentors & SafeTalk (or ASIST) . Additional Training also available. Schedule will be provided. Submit time after each visit using online form.

After each visit, record hours. Debrief with program staff .

After each visit, record using online form. Debrief with staff.



Ongoing Tasks: Participate in development reviews at 3 months, one year and annually thereafter. This will include both in person and over the phone conversations.
Participate in online surveys as requested by Mentors Matter program.
